INTRODUCTION

History: Shri Mata Mansa Devi Government Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya, Panchkula is the first Government Sanskrit college in Haryana which was established in July, 2020 with the objective that it would become, in near future, an institution of great significance for Indian culture, heritage and dissemination of Sanskrit. Named after Mata Mansa Devi, a *Shakti Peeth*, the college at present runs from the temporary building in the premises of Shri Mata Mansa Devi Temple situated in Panchkula, Haryana. The Mata Mansa Devi Shrine Board has earmarked 2.10 acres in the vicinity of the temple for setting up of Post Graduate Sanskrit College.

Courses Offered: The college, at present, offers Undergraduate Courses in Visharad and Shastri, and Diplomas in *Jyotish*, *Karmakand* and Proficiency in Sanskrit (introduced this year) which run in evening. The college is affiliated to Maharshi Valmiki Sanskrit University, Kaithal for Shastri Program and Diplomas; and Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra for Visharad Program. The college aims to introduce, in near future, Postgraduate courses in Sanskrit (*Acharya*) and Diploma in *Yoga*.

Departments in College: There are six departments in the college – Department of Sanskrit, Department of English, Department of Hindi, Department of Physical Education, Department of Political Science, Department of Public Administration and Department of Computer Science.

IMPORTANT MILESTONES OF THE COLLEGE

Shila Nyasa–Foundation Stone-laying Ceremony: The ‘Foundation Stone-laying Ceremony’ of the college was held virtually. The Foundation stone was unveiled virtually by Hon’ble CM of Haryana, Sh. Manohar Lal Khattar on 18th July, 2023 in a program held at PWD Guest House, Panchkula with Sh. Gian Chand Gupta, Speaker, Vidhan Sabha and MLA, Panchkula in the chair.

Bhoomi Poojan Ceremony: The Bhoomi Poojan Ceremony of the college was conducted on 21st October, 2023. Sh. Gian Chand Gupta, Hon’ble Speaker, Vidhan Sabha and MLA, Panchkula performed pooja and laid the first brick of foundation of the college. The ceremony was attended by Dr K.C. The college receives '**Braille Newsletter**' from Reliance Foundation, Mumbai twice a month (i.e. on 1st and 16th of every month). Distributed in 15 countries of the world, this newsletter is vital for the visually challenged. The District Red Cross, Panchkula has been informed about the availability of newspaper and asked to inform the interested people to contact the college library to read or issue it.

Panini Prachya Anveshan Vidya Kendra: A Research and Development Centre has been set up in the college library to encourage students of Sanskrit to take up research. The center intends to set up a language lab in the college and formulate an Academic MoU with other educational institutes and centers to get student grants and projects. The **Co-Ordinator** of the center is **Dr. Renuka Dhyani, Associate Professor, Department of English.** The Centre organized the following activities in the Session 2023-24:

1. Convened and participated in a few sessions of Academic Karma: An Academic Collaboration with Institute for Applied Sanskrit Shaasritya Knowledge, Chandigarh to hold Webinars and Open-House Discussions with scholars from across India.

2. Introduced ‘Sanskrit Shaastriya-based Games’ in the college under the guidance of Dr Ashutosh Angiras, Director, Institute of Applied Sanskrit Shaastriya Knowledge, Chandigarh.
3. Organized the demonstration of Sanskrit-Shaastriya-based Games (*Skand-yudha*, *Hasti-yudha*, *Ashwaarohi Raj-rakshanam* and *Bandikarnam*) at the ‘International Conference of ‘Physical Education and Multi-disciplinary Sciences’ held at Government Postgraduate College, Sector-1, Panchkula.
4. Organized One day Workshop for students on ‘Computer Proficiency in Sanskrit’ and a lecture on ‘Research Opportunities for Sanskrit Students’ on 26th April 2024.

Hostel Facility: The college also provides hostel facility to the boy and girl students. 22 students reside in the campus. Dr Rajbir, Lecturer, Department of Sanskrit is the Warden of the hostel. Dr. Daisy Rani, Assistant Professor, Department of Physical Education is the In-Charge of the Hostel Committee.

Multi-purpose Gym: There is Multi-purpose Gym in the college which is open to students and staff of the college. **Dr. Daisy Rani, Assistant Professor, Department of Physical Education** is the **In-Charge** of gym.
